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Construction on the new Championship Course is well under way

Stage 1 works to deliver the new Championship Course of the North Adelaide Public Golf Course are well under way. Despite periods of heavy rain, the first phase of Kikuyu grass removal and earthworks is progressing well with the new undulating fairways of holes 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 taking shape.

The new fairway designs provide more open corridors and feature multiple tee options to cater for players of all abilities, from first-timers to championship players.

Occupying the eastern end of Park 1, these fairways offer dramatic elevation from the corner of Strangways Terrace, with sweeping views toward the Adelaide skyline.

In addition to crafting the new fairways, the team has also been busy sculpting bold new bunkers. Also progressing is the installation of new drainage and irrigation systems and laying of top soil in preparation for the seeding of new grass in Spring.



In with the Couch, out with the Kikuyu

As part of the upgrade, grass on the Championship Course will be converted from Kikuyu grass to Couch grass.

Why you ask?



Kikuyu grass is a highly invasive species that offers less driving distance for players and will invade the bunkers and native vegetation faster than you can say 'triple bogey'.

Couch grass on the other hand provides a firm and consistent surface that facilitates more dynamic play with greater roll. It is drought tolerant and self-repairing, making it suitable for high-traffic settings such as the Park Lands.



First bunkers are built!

The very first bunkers of the Championship Course have been built. Located on the new Hole 3, these bunkers are deep and steep, making for challenging play.

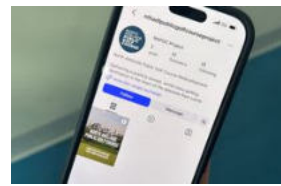


Over 130 years of golfing history in the Park Lands
