



Local Rule – Relief from renovation works

The Match Committee wishes to advise that ACC ground staff have carried out renovation works on the course which has resulted in cores holes on fairways and cores that have been piled at various locations around the course for removal at a later date.

Based on this the Match Committee will adopt a Local Rule for relief if your ball comes to rest in these areas of piled cores or a core hole.

Players can take relief from the **piled cores** by selecting the nearest point of relief, not closer to the hole and **drop** their ball within 1 club length.

The ground staff have renovated areas around the course that have been marked as GUR with Drop Zones identified around the GUR patches.

The Match Committee wishes to clarify that if your ball comes to rest in an area identified as GUR and there is a Drop Zone(s) identified them you must remove your ball from the GUR and you can drop it in the <u>nearest</u> Drop Zone which may or may not be closer to the hole in play.

Normal rules apply if you are in a GUR that does not have an identified Drop Zone.

This rule will commence 13th November and will remain in place for competitions until further notice.
