Equal Opportunity

Following an approach from Golf Australia, we looked into our policy on this matter and were found to be in line with guidelines. NAGC has been a leader in equal opportunity provisions in the golf world with female committee members and a Lady President in the recent past but we discovered that when the Golf Course took over the scoring system there was an anomaly that has now been altered. We also discovered that many women members were not completely aware that they could book anytime on a Saturday should this be required. This has happened in the past by several players who needed an earlier match than that provided by the women's competition times and booked through the NAGC booking system.

<u>Mi-Club Booking System has now been altered to allow any female member to book in, at the</u> <u>appropriate opening times, for the Saturday competition should they wish to play earlier than that</u> <u>provided for the Women's competition.</u>

Golf Course Management - Systems Upgrade.

Please note that a new Point of Sale and Management System will be implemented by the golf course management which will entail the following:

1. LOYALTY cards will be issued to each member which will hold your balances and discount status – a scan will be required when purchasing goods and services. Discounts will be inbuilt on the cards

2. Photos will be included on the card so please cooperate with staff to have your picture taken.

3. You will be UNABLE to access your current card balances from February 3rd - February 14th so please make provision for cash transactions during this period.

4. Login details for online bookings will not change (several exceptions who will be contacted separately) but the only change will be online bookings on Monday 10th February will not be available until the Tuesday.

Overall, the new system will be quicker and more efficient so please be a little patient for the week of Feb 10-16th as the new system is rolled out.

The Golf Course staff will be there to help you.

We will also be analysing public groups who play in between our tee-off times to monitor any problems in that area.
